Job Overview

1. Love Jesus and cultivate a heart for Him and His people at Resurrection.
2. Provide overall leadership for Women’s Ministries at Resurrection.
3. Provide individual and corporate pastoring to the women at Resurrection.
4. Teach and oversee other teachers to provide high quality weekly Bible Studies.
5. Develop opportunities for women to connect and encourage one another in large groups, small groups, and one on one meetings including but not limited to fellowship events, a yearly retreat, leadership development opportunities, outreach events and discipleship training.
6. Assist in leading corporate worship and supporting worship ministries.
7. Fulfill other pastoral responsibilities in accordance with calling, gifting, and training.
