General Information

Registration and Payment

There is only one way to register, which is through an electronic form that can be found at resbalt.org/israel. Your spot will only be reserved when the office receives your **deposit of \$500** per person (mail a check to 11525 Greenspring Ave. Lutherville, MD 21093). Please submit your flight information at resbalt.org/israel. By December 10, 2022, your trip must be paid in full (**\$3,200 per person, double occupancy; an additional \$1,100 for single occupancy travelers**). Single travelers may request to be assigned a roommate to avoid paying the single occupancy fee.

Important Dates

- **Upon Registration:** Submit a \$500 deposit with each registrant
- **December 10, 2022:** Registrants must be paid in full (\$3,200 total per person, additional \$1,100 for single traveler).
- **January, 2023:** Mandatory meeting with trip participants (exact date TBD).
- **February 5–17, 2023:** Israel trip!

Flights

Please book your flights into Ben Gurion, Tel Aviv, to arrive no later than 5:15pm on Monday, February 6, 2023. All participants are responsible for transportation to/from their departing airport. (If we find that the majority of trip participants are flying out of Dulles/BWI at the same time, Res might decide to offer transportation to the airport at an additional cost, in which case, you will be notified of this option.) Returning flights should be booked to leave Tel Aviv between 5:00am–12:00pm on Friday, February 17. Transportation to/from the airport will be provided for flights that leave after 5:00am. For those who book a returning flight before 5:00am on Friday, February 17, they will be responsible for their transportation from Christ Church, Jerusalem to Ben Gurion, Tel Aviv (roughly \$100 for an Uber).

Other Notes

- Expect to walk at least 4 miles per day while in Israel.
- The local time in Israel is 7 hours ahead of EDT.
- Tap water is safe to drink in Israel, and bottled water is available in most places. Breakfast and dinner will be provided each day, with each trip participant responsible for their own lunch (roughly 65–110 NIS each, cash only).
- You can request NIS from your local bank three weeks prior to the trip, bring dollars to exchange, or withdraw NIS using an ATM if your card is honored in Israel. Bring a valid major credit card and alert your bank of travel.

Before the Trip

- Confirm that you have a passport that is valid through August 17, 2023.
- Obtain *mandatory* travel insurance with COVID coverage, within 14 days of the trip (we suggest Allianz Travel at allianztravelinsurance.com).
- Make sure that you have European electrical plug adapters (and that your electronics can handle 230V, 50Hz AC).
- Check with your cell phone provider about international calls/texts. Wifi will be available most evenings.
- Read the Bible (we recommend reading the four Gospels) and prepare to meet God in Israel as we explore the life and world of Jesus together.
