## **Guide for Bible Readings**

- What's something you noticed for the first time?
- What questions did you have?
- Was there anything that bothered you?
- What did you learn about loving God?
- What did you learn about loving others?
- How would you apply this text to your own life?
- Are there any actions to take as a result of this reading?

Use two different translations if you can.
