

Packing List

Cuirim House – Summer 2019

- Passport
- Bible, Journal, & Pen
- Water Bottle- reusable
- Toiletries (Shampoo, Soap, Deodorant, Toothbrush, Toothpaste, Chapstick etc.)
- Hat
- Sunscreen
- Work Gloves
- Work Clothes (for 5 days – old jeans/pants & t-shirts, shorts)
- Girls*
 - » Capri pants
 - » Basketball length/knee length shorts (no running shorts)
 - » Tops (no tank tops or spaghetti straps, sleeveless shirts are ok)
- Casual Sunday Clothes for Church
 - » (polo/button up for guys; knee length skirt for girls)
- Closed toe shoes
 - » Old Sneakers/Work Boots/slip-ons for the evenings
- Shower Shoes
- Modest Pajamas
- One Long-sleeve shirt or Light Jacket
- Clothes to wear on travel days
- Modest bathing suit for hotel
- Twin bed sheets, pillow case & towel
- Dirty Clothes Bag
- Flashlight
- Any medicine you need – if prescription, keep in original bottles
- Money for Cokes or snacks in Mexico and for the Market on Friday (Smaller bills; \$1 are better)

*Note for girls:

- » Sleeveless blouses, but no spaghetti strap tops or tank tops
- » Also, only long, knee length shorts or capris. It is out of respect for the Mexican people/culture – you won't see many Mexican women wearing shorts.
- » No hair dryers – they blow the fuse!
