POSITION SUMMARY

The Children's Ministry Director fulfills Resurrection's mission to know Christ and make Him known by creating age-appropriate structures and content to proclaim the gospel to children while recruiting, equipping, and leading a volunteer team to implement the overall Children's ministry strategic plan. They will also seek to equip and help parents be the primary leaders of their children's growth in Christ. The children's program shall consist of relational ministry, Sunday worship programming, special events and equipping parents.

Strategic Execution

- Work closely with the Executive Director to execute the church's vision and strategic plan by proclaiming the gospel to children and their parents.
- Providing high quality and safe programming during worship services and throughout the year.
- Identify, equip, lead, and care for volunteers to be the primary leaders of the children's ministry.
- Offer non worship service opportunities like the pageant prep, first communion, easter Family fun day and summer adventure camp for kids, parents, and volunteers to encounter Christ.

Programming and Volunteer Development

- Through the power of the Holy Spirit initiate and lead opportunities for Resurrection children and their parents to know Jesus and grow spiritually, biblically, relationally, and missionally.
- Evangelize and disciple children to know, serve, and love Jesus and make Him known.
- Equip the saints for acts of service by recruiting, equipping and leading a Children's ministry Team.
- Equip parents to lead their children spiritually.
- Oversee Sunday morning content and programming for children's ages newborn through 5th grade.
- Work with the Assistant Children's Ministry Directory to lead a Christmas Pageant, Easter Family Fun Day, First Communion Class, and Summer Adventure Camp.
- Pray for children and volunteers at Resurrection. Develop Intercessory Prayer Team for Ministry.
