

Two Year Anglican Pastoral Residency

Church of the Resurrection, an Anglican Church located in Baltimore County, MD is searching for exceptional seminary graduates or newly ordained clergy, committed to Jesus Christ, proclaiming the gospel, and a lifetime of serving as leaders in the Anglican Church to participate in a two year Pastoral Residency Program.

Resident Program Overview:

Through the Pastoral Residency program, Resurrection seeks to build upon a strong seminary foundation by providing an opportunity for personal development and advanced practical training to prepare Residents to lead or plant churches in the Anglican tradition. Over the course of two years, Pastoral Residents will work full-time, gaining experience in a broad range of pastoral and leadership responsibilities while receiving the support of a church family, experienced clergy, and coaches. Pastoral Residents will be asked to cultivate both the “being” and “doing” of leadership development in order to grow in character and skills to lead or plant a congregation.

Core Elements May Include:

- Preaching, Teaching and Leading Bible Studies
- Pastoral Care
- Leading Worship
- Personal Evangelism and Discipleship
- Prayer and Healing Ministry
- Church Administration, Planning, and Budgeting of Resources
- Church Planting

Salary and Benefits:

Pastoral Residents will receive a \$55,000 yearly stipend with the invitation to raise an additional \$15,000 of salary (Total potential cash compensation of \$70,000 per year). Resurrection will provide health insurance benefits for the resident up to \$6,000, 4 weeks vacation/5 days of sick leave, administrative support, and will cover other specific ministry expenses. Applicants with families are welcome to apply. Potential housing maybe available.

Application Process:

Applications for the Pastoral Residency position will be received beginning December 1, 2022. Selected candidates will be interviewed on a first come, first serve basis. Resurrection is currently seeking to hire the first Pastoral Resident as of June 1, 2023. Anglican Ordination or pending ordination is required.

A complete application includes the following:

- A current resume
- One paragraph describing conversion to Jesus Christ.
- One paragraph describing prior ministry experience.
- One paragraph describing reasons why candidate wants to participate in the Pastoral Residency.
- One paragraph describing specific ministry areas candidate seeks more experience.
