The **Senior Associate Clergy** fulfills Church of the Resurrection's mission "to know Christ and make Him known" by overseeing worship services and worship ministries, providing leadership over pastoral staff and lay leaders, and pastoring the congregation through prayer, pastoral care, teaching, preaching and leading corporate worship.

POSITION SUMMARY

The Senior Associate is an ordained clergy role that provides leadership for worship services and related ministries. The Senior Associate oversees and equips ministry lay leaders and teams including alter guild, ushers, acolytes, worship assistants, chalicists, prayer ministers, greeters, tech team, connections, and fellowship. The Senior Associate will provide pastoral care and oversight to pastoral staff including Directors of Women's Ministry, Men's Ministry, Pastoral Care, Assistant clergy, Student Ministry, Pastoral Residents, and Faithworks staff. The Senior Associate will participate in worship planning and execution as well as have a ministry of preaching and teaching.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

- Work closely with the Rector to implement the church's vision and strategic plan for all worship services and worship related ministries.
- Identify, equip, nurture and lead ministry leaders of vibrant worship ministries in the church.
- Provide overall leadership for all weekend worship ministries.
- Provide oversight and pastoral care to pastoral staff.
- Participate and lead worship services, marriages, and funerals.
- Provide mentoring and coaching to pastoral residents.
- Provide individual and corporate pastoring of the congregation and staff.

POSITION REQUIREMENTS

- A clear, personal, mature, articulate relationship with Jesus Christ expressed in a personal, corporate, vibrant, and infectious life of worship.
- Genuine love for people and a servant's heart to invest and disciple them.
- The ability to be a leader of leaders in ministry more than a doer of ministry.
- Ability to lay aside personal preferences for worship while developing worship services.
- Demonstrated ability to coach leaders who equip volunteers for ministry.
- Demonstrated success in situations that require initiative and an entrepreneurial spirit.
- Excellent written and verbal and communication skills.
- Strong time-management, multi-tasking abilities, and self-starter skills
- Proficiency with Microsoft office suite and Mac OS.
- Satisfactory background check and references.
