

SUMMER INTERN 2023

DESCRIPTION AND APPLICATION



Church of the Resurrection offers a ten-week summer internship to seminary students on an Anglican ordination track who have completed their 1st or 2nd year of seminary. The internship is specifically designed to offer a broad range of parish experience that helps prepare seminarians to apply their theological knowledge to practical parish experience.

The summer internship offers opportunities to learn and participate in the following areas of church life: preaching, teaching, pastoral care, church governance, evangelism, discipleship, prayer ministry, church planting, liturgy and worship, church finances and administration, and children's ministry.

Each intern will meet weekly with a leadership coach and three times with a lay team who serve to support and encourage the intern. The intern will attend all staff meetings, Vestry meetings, meet regularly with pastoral staff, preach at least once, and teach a 4 or 5 week adult education course. The internship generally begins on or around June 1 and ends on or around August 15th. There is a \$4,000 stipend given to each intern and housing is made available. Food, travel, and transportation are the intern's responsibility.
